## **Sherwood Veterans Day Ceremony**

On Friday November 11, at 11:00 a.m. The City of Sherwood held a wonderful Veterans Day Ceremony at The Sherwood Center for the Arts. We had a recruiting table set up in the foyer with Georgia DeLozier and Mikkinsy Saling handing out Legion, SAL and Auxiliary literature.

The ceremony started with a brief thank you speech by Sherwood Mayor Keith Mays followed by presentation of the Colors by Post 56 Color Guard members Ken Sandquist and Ryan Shockley. After the Pledge of Allegiance, the Sherwood High School A-Cappella Choir "The Mixolydians" sang the National Anthem. They were absolutely fantastic.

Next was the Invocation by Wilson Parrish, Chaplain of the Sherwood Police Department followed by another Mixolydians song, "And So It Goes" by Billy Joel. There were then two guest speakers, Sherwood Council President Tim Rosener and Sig Unander. Tim spoke on Veterans history and the new U.S. Space Force, a very interesting speech. Sig gave a speech, with photo slides, talking about the importance of the women of service men, who he referred to as the untold Veterans, who worked during WWII building all types of military equipment and supplies. He said that without them we would not have won the war. It was a very heart warming and educational speech.

The Mixolydians then sang the Armed Forces medley for the Army, Marines, Navy, Air Force, Space Force and Coast Guard. The Ceremony concluded with a Benediction and then Post 56 Color Guard retiring the colors. If you did not attend, I would encourage you to attend next year.
