As your new Service Officer, I would like to share with the Post members some of my duties. I will be serving as a link between our members and a representative that can file claims on behalf of veterans. I am not authorized to file any claims, only to assist in locating an accredited trained Service Officer. Oregon Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) certifies all Oregon county service officers for the Veterans Benefits Administration to provide claims representation for Oregon veterans. ODVA trains and accredits Veterans Service Officers to file defensible claims for disability based on Title 38 federal law. If you need a contact telephone number, contact me and I will provide you with one.

I can also provide various resources to members such as State and National cemeteries, nursing homes, agencies for senior citizens and other organizations that help veterans. Depending on your disability rating, the State offers a wide variety of benefits to you. I can also provide more information on who to contact if you are eligible.
